

BAHAMA BONUS BLACKJACK PROGRESSIVE

Bahama Bonus Blackjack Progressive is an optional progressive bet. The bet considers the best hand possible among each individual player's first initial two cards. When there is more than one (1) qualified progressive jackpot hand, requiring a 100% payout, the jackpot is divided equally amongst each qualifying 100% winner. Multiple qualifying progressive winners other than 100% are each paid according to the progressive table. The displayed progressive prize may be modified or discontinued at any time without prior notice.

The game is played with six decks. The only exception to the standard deck is that all number "10" cards are removed. (A Spanish deck of cards consists of Ace to 9, Jack, Queen, and King.)

HOW TO PLAY BAHAMA BONUS BLACKJACK PROGRESSIVE

The game play of Bahama Bonus Blackjack is very similarly to traditional blackjack, however there are some important variations to point out.

Players may double down on two or more cards, as well as double down after splitting. Players can split cards of equal value, including aces, up to three times, creating four hands. When splitting, aces are treated like any other card (whereas in normal 21, aces may only be split once receiving only one card per ace.) Hitting and doubling down of split hands, including aces, is allowed. All 21's get paid automatically. A player Blackjack always beats a dealers Blackjack and is paid 3 to 2. Player may re-double after doubling down for a total of three doubles.

When the dealer's face up card is an ace or a face card, they check under the card for Blackjack. Insurance and late surrender are allowed. Insurance is a side bet that the dealer has 21 when showing an ace. Insurance may be taken for up to half the original bet and pays 2 to 1. Surrender allows the player to forfeit half of their wager and drop from the hand. The player cannot surrender when the dealer has a blackjack or after taking a hit.

Another rule variation of Bahama Bonus Blackjack is the Double Down Rescue. If the player receives an unfavorable card after doubling down on any number of cards, the player may indicate to the dealer that they would like to Rescue their Double Down bet. The dealer will return the last double down and the player forfeits their hand and original bet. This can be done on the 1st, 2nd or 3rd double.

The dealer must hit soft 17 or less. A soft 17 is any combination of cards that equal seven or less with one of those cards being an Ace. When the sum of a hand is equal to 17 and includes a 10 value card, that is called hard 17 and the dealer stays.

BONUS 21 PAYOFFS

Certain player 21 totals result in a Bonus 21 Payoff. Bonuses are not paid on doubled hands.

BONUS 21 PAYOUTS

Five card 21	3 to 2
Six card 21	2 to 1
Seven+ card 21	3 to 1
6-7-8 mixed suit 21	3 to 2
6-7-8 suited 21	2 to 1
6-7-8 suited spades 21	3 to 1
7-7-7 mixed suit 21	3 to 2
7-7-7 suited 21	2 to 1
7-7-7 suited spades 21	3 to 1

MATCH THE DEALER (up card and down card)

Players can also make a Match the Dealer bet. In addition to the regular bet, a player can bet that either of their first two cards, or both, will match the dealer's up card in rank. The Match the Dealer bet has a minimum of \$1 with a maximum of \$25.

MATCH THE DEALER PAYOUTS

1 non-suited match	4 to 1
2 non-suited matches	8 to 1
1 suited match	9 to 1
1 non-suited & 1 suited	13 to 1
2 suited matches	18 to 1

SPECIAL BONUS PAYOFF

A player is eligible for a Special Bonus if they receive a hand of three suited sevens, and the dealer's up card is any seven. No additional wagers are required for the Special Bonus payout. All other regular wager betting players receive a \$50 Envy Bonus when another player wins a Special Bonus, even if they lose the regular Bahama Bonus Blackjack wager. The Special Bonus winner does not receive the Envy payout. Splitting or doubling down voids the Special Bonus. The payout for the Special Bonus is \$1,000 (fixed) to THE WINNING PLAYER.

Three-of-a-Kind	\$10
Suited Pair	\$2

HOUSE RULES
