FOUR CARD POKER

Four Card Poker is a game that rewards skill, patience and nerve. Similar to Three Card Poker but with one major difference. In Three Card Poker, the play wager must equal the ante; in Four Card Poker, players may bet up to three times the ante when staying in the game.

Four Card Poker is played with standard 52-card deck. Five cards are distributed to each player by the dealer from an automatic shuffling machine. The dealer then deals themselves six cards with the top card face up.

HOW TO PLAY FOUR CARD POKER

To begin a round, the player places a wager on the ante and/or the Aces Up bet. The ante wager indicates the player wants to compare their hand against the dealer's, and the Aces Up bet is a wager that the player will have Pair of Aces or better.

Players use their best four of five the cards dealt, whereas the dealer uses the best four of six cards dealt. Players only play against the dealer, not any of the other players at the table.

After being dealt a hand you can either fold (forfeit) your hand and ante wager, or continue playing by placing a play wager in an amount at least equal to the ante and up to three times the ante. If the player folds, the hand is over and the dealer collects the player's ante wager and the Aces Up bet.

The ante and play bets win 1 to 1. The player wins ties. Players who place an ante wager and play wager are eligible to win an automatic bonus payout.

AUTOMATIC BONUS (NOT DEPENDENT ON DEALER'S HAND):

Four of a Kind Straight Flush Three of a Kind 25 to 1 20 to 1 2 to 1

RANKING OF HANDS FROM HIGHEST TO LOWEST:

Four of a Kind, Straight Flush, Three of a Kind, Flush, Straight, Two Pair, and a Pair of Aces.

FOUR CARD POKER PROGRESSIVE

PROGRESSIVE PAYOUTS

The optional \$1 progressive bet wins if you have Three of a Kind or better. See paytable for odds. If you receive Four Aces, you win 100% of the progressive Jackpot.

ENVY BONUSES

If you have placed the optional \$1 Progressive Jackpot wager, you are eligible for the Envy Bonus. The top two hands trigger Envy Bonuses and you win if any other player gets Four Aces or Four of a Kind. You can win multiple Envy Bonuses in a round, but you cannot receive Envy Bonuses for your own hand or the dealer's hand.

BAD BEAT BONUS

Player may Bad Beat the dealer, or the dealer may Bad Beat the player. If the player and the dealer's four card hands tie, the Bad Beat Bonus side bet loses.

HAND BEATEN:

Four of a Kind Straight Flush Three of a Kind Flush Straight Two Pair 10,000 to 1 5,000 to 1 100 to 1 25 to 1 20 to 1 5 to 1

HOUSE RULES

Players may play more than one hand at supervisor's discretion. Side betting is strictly prohibited on the casino floor. All decisions made by the Floor Supervisor are final.
