

# ROYAL MATCH 21

Royal Match is played on a standard blackjack table with a special layout and two to six standard decks of cards. The layout resembles the standard layout with the addition of a Royal Match betting circle to the upper right of the “21” betting area. The Crown Treasure marker is a non-value marker used to designate that a player is eligible for the Crown Treasure payoff.

## PLAYER BETS

- Players must make a “21” wager
- Royal Match bets are optional
- Initial Royal Match bets must be made at the same time as the “21” bet”
- Players may make a Royal Match bet for each of their “21” bets
- Players may not make a Royal Match wager on split cards
- Others may not wager on other player’s betting area
- Royal Match bets may be larger than the “21” bet, up to the Royal Match maximum limit

## CROWN TREASURE

When a player makes a Royal Match bet and is dealt a King and Queen of the same suit, they immediately receive the posted payoff of 25 to 1. The dealer will cap, with the Crown Treasure marker, the Royal Match bet immediately if the dealer has a King or Queen showing. If the dealer’s down card completes the King and Queen matched suit (does not have to be same suit as the player), the player receives an additional bonus payoff of \$1,000 regardless of the amount of the Royal Match bet.

### Example:

Player A makes a \$1 Royal Match bet and player B makes a \$5 Royal Match bet and they both receive a King and Queen of the same suit. They both receive an immediate payoff of 25 to 1. If the dealer also receives a King and Queen of the same suit then each player would receive an additional bonus of \$1,000.

**CLEARING THE LAYOUT**

After all players have received their first two cards, all Royal Match bets are settled. The Royal Match bets are either picked up or paid out by paying and taking from right to left. If the first two cards dealt to a player are the same suit, the player is paid 2½ to 1. If playing on a double deck game, Royal Match bets are settled before hit/stand of each hand.

If the first two cards dealt to a player are the King and Queen of the same suit, the dealer will call out “Royal Match” to the Floor person and the player is paid out 25 to 1. After all Royal Match bets have been settled, normal “21” play resumes.

**GENERAL RULES**

Winning bets will be paid in front of the Royal Match betting circle and will be pushed off toward the player.

Players may make the Royal Match token bet for the dealers, and the token bet will be paid off the same pay-chart as the players, except the dealers do not receive a \$1,000 bonus.

**MINIMUM AND MAXIMUM BETS**

Minimum Royal Match bet.....\$1

Maximum Royal Match bet.....\$25

**PAYOUT CHART**

First two cards of the same suit.....2½ to 1

First two cards are a Blackjack of the same suit.....5 to 1

First two cards are a King and Queen of same suit...25 to 1

First two cards are King and Queen of the same suit and dealer’s cards are a King and Queen of the same suit.....\$1,000

**HOUSE RULES**

For all winning Royal bets, cards must be placed up on the table. Side betting is strictly prohibited on the casino floor.
